- International law is one tool of ocean governance




What is the main legal setting for international ocean governance?

- Maritime zones govern the degree of sovereignty of coastal States
- Governance of the global commons depends upon cooperation and the degree to which international institutions have a mandate to regulate

- Multitude of international treaties on different issues related to the oceans
- UN Convention on the Law of the Sea as the main legal framework
- Soft law



Why is international legal governance of the oceans so difficult?

- In principle, international law is only as effective as it is supported by the political will of States
- Certain fundamental principles like the reliance upon flag-state jurisdiction on the high seas are obstacles to more effective regulation



What are the main issues and tools for future ocean governance?

- Dynamic treaties and strong institutions
- More effective compliance control e.g. by port States
- Better interaction between policymaking, law and science
- Integrated processes to balance different uses of the oceans
