- completed summary sheet (pdf, for internal use only)
- a one- to two-page testimonial (word format)
- an academic CV (pdf)
- a current list of publications (pdf)

- up to five most important publications (pdf) and a short explanation of your own contribution to each publication (2-3 sentences each on a separate sheet, please indicate if peer-reviewed)

The presidential board of Kiel University will identify two nominees for the Heinz Maier Leibniz Prize 2019 from all applicants to be put forward by Kiel University.
