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Innovative presentation methods for early career researcher participants

- **Pecha Kucha** (Japanese: *chit-chat*) is a presentation style in which 20 slides are shown for 20 seconds each (**6 minutes and 40 seconds** total). The format, keeps presentations concise and fast-paced. The audience will have **five minutes for questions**.
- **PowToon** is free Web-based animation software that allows users to create animated presentations in cartoon style by manipulating pre-created objects, imported images, provided music and user created voice-overs. PowToon presentations will consist of a **seven minute talk plus five minutes for audience questions**.
- **Old School** presentations use only a chalkboard and chalk. **Seven minute talk plus five minutes for audience questions**.
- **Dance your Research** – based on the “Dance your PhD” contests, participants interpret their research through dance, using props where appropriate. **Seven minute performance plus five minutes for audience questions**.
- **FameLab style** (adapted from the Cheltenham Science Festival and Nesta) Participants present their topic using only objects they can carry on stage without any electronic devices. The topic should be easy to listen to, entertaining and exciting. **Seven minute talk plus five minutes for audience questions**.
- **Twin Talk** If you choose this option you will be paired with another twin talker. You will each give the other’s talk. **Seven minute talk plus five minutes for audience questions**.
- **Poster presentation with elevator pitch talk** – Each poster (portrait format) Size DIN A0 (118.9 x 84.1). Your pitch talk will be presented with a **three minute pitch talk** with up to three slides total (one title slide with title, authors, affiliations, two further slides) in plenary and in the evening poster sessions.
