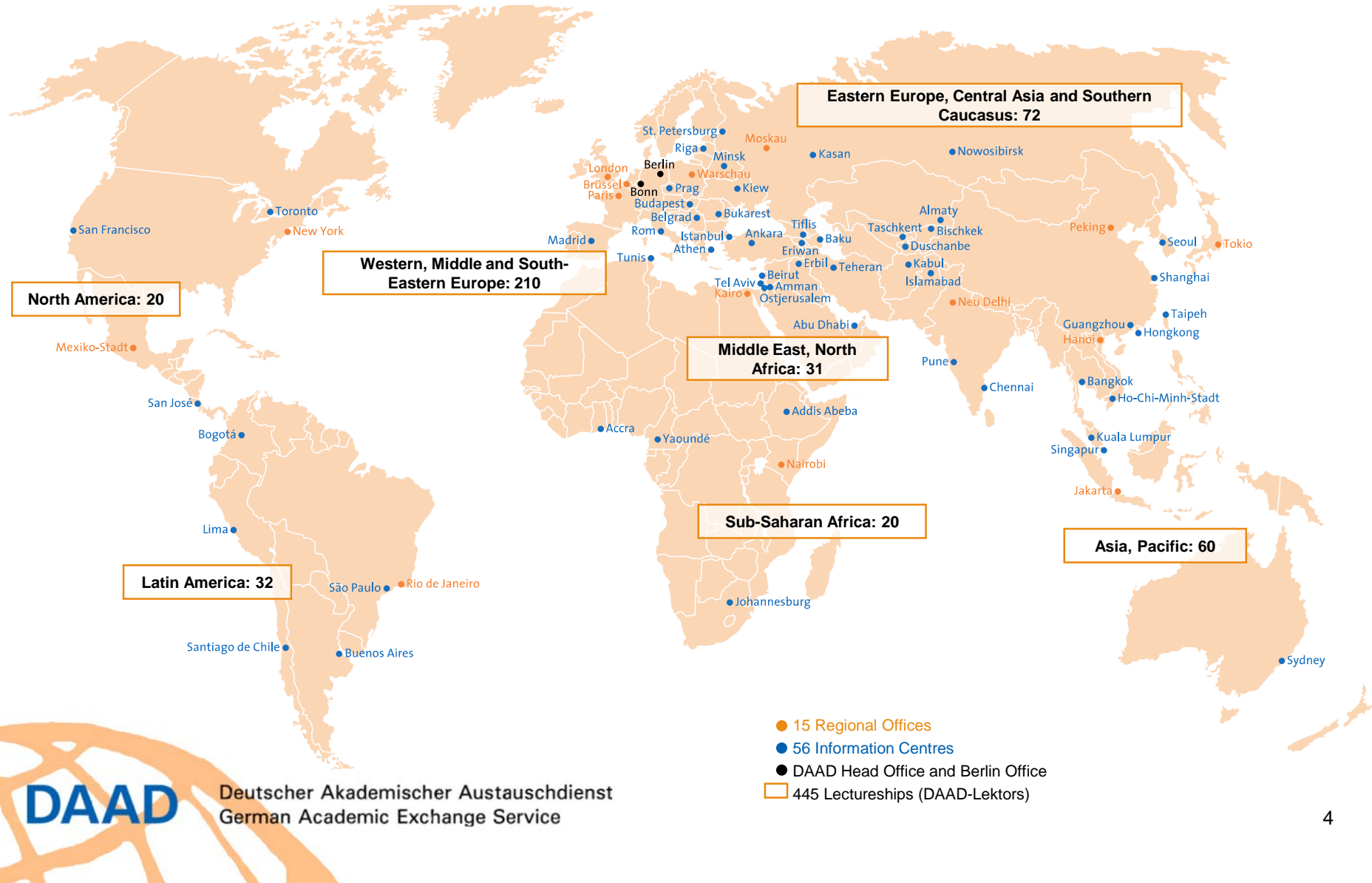

- 107 student bodies

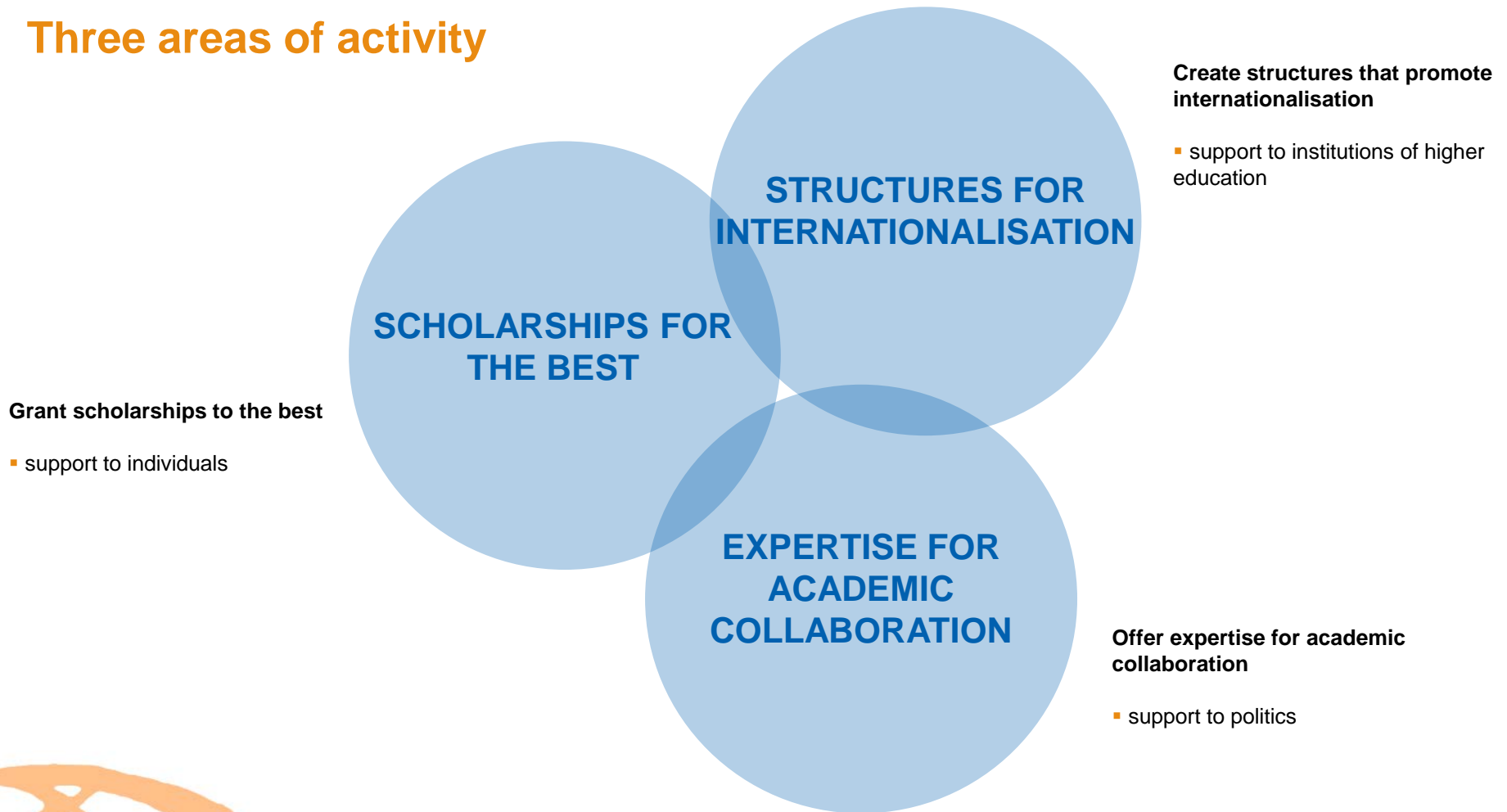

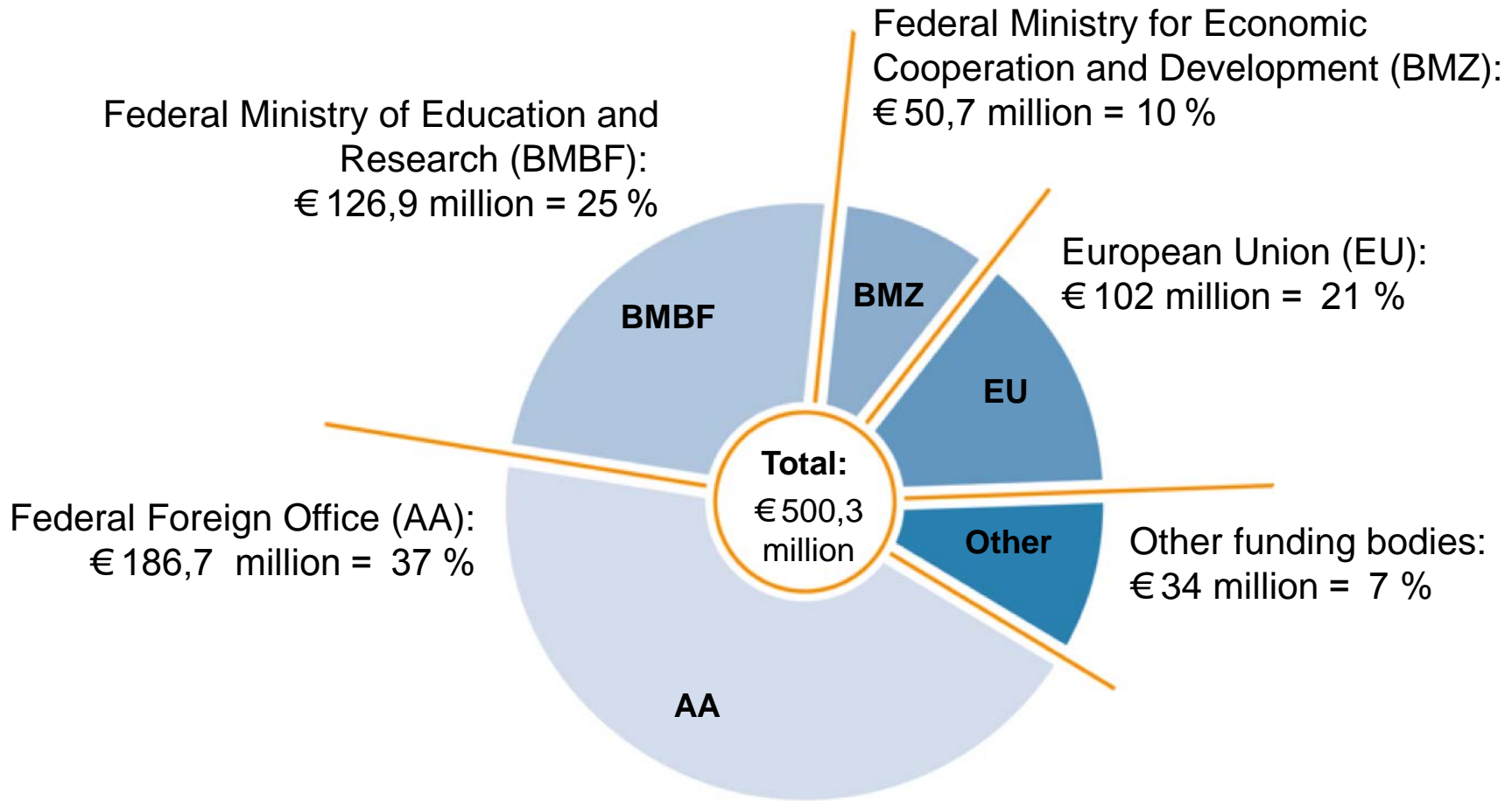

1. DAAD Research Grants – Short Term / Long Term



Objective: Further academic qualification

- Research in libraries, archives, labs, field
- All disciplines
- All destinations
- Short Term: 1-6 months (*no extension*)
- Long Term: 7-12 months (*opt for extension*)

DAAD Funding for Doctoral Students

Short / Long Term Research Grants - Eligibility



- eligible if German graduation certificate or equivalent
- plus accepted as doctoral student by a German university
- not eligible holders of scholarships funded by a „Begabtenförderungswerk“
- partly eligible DFG Graduate Collegiates
- please note special regulations for bi-nationally supervised dissertations

Short / Long Term Research Grants – Add Ons



- travel allowance, amount depending on target country
- standard insurance (health, life and accident, liability)
- monthly allowance
for research and congress participation (€ 102)
- for one-year scholarships only:
 - - Tuition fees (limited in amount)
 - - Child allowance and insurance
 - - Marital allowance and partner insurance

DAAD Funding for Doctoral Students Short / Long Term Research Grants - Deadlines



■ deadlines depend on target country

- 2 – 3 x per year
- Selection board meeting: + 2-4 months
- Earliest start + 2-4 months

**Time span between
application deadline and start – 6 months approx.**

- ✓ online application form / www.daad.de / Stipendiendatenbank
- ✓ resumee
- ✓ research project outline including detailed time schedule
- ✓ invitation by host institution
- ✓ two up to date letters of assessment by your German supervisors
- ✓ latest academic certificate / including transcript of records
- ✓ language certificate
- ✓ list of publications
- ✓ diploma thesis abstract (master thesis, state examination thesis)
- ✓ For one-year scholarships: full text version of your thesis

DAAD Funding for Doctoral Students

Short / Long Term Res. Grants – Selection Criteria



- quality of research project
(originality, topicality, method/s, feasibility)
- „good match“ between project and host institution
- past academic performance
- list of publications
- (personality)
- (extra-curricular activities)

Objective: Increase interest among computer scientists in a scientific career and international collaboration

- Short Term Scholarships
- 1-6 months
- For stays at research labs worldwide, including non-university and profit oriented research groups

- duration of selection process – three months
- application docs and selection process cf. short term scholarships for doctoral students

Travel Grants for Conferences - Objective



- Funded**
- Travels abroad to
 - Conferences or Invited Talks
 - Destinations in Germany are not supported
- For task**
- “Active participation”
 - = Presentation of talk or poster
- Duration**
- Conferences: maximum 8 days
 - Invited talks: maximum 10 days

Travel Grants for Conferences - Funding



Conference funding

- DAAD travel allowance
- Daily allowance for board and accommodation
- Conference fees (early bird rate)

Invited talks funding

- DAAD travel allowance

DAAD Funding for Doctoral Students

Travel Grants for Conferences - Figures



- Frequency ➤ Every 12 months
- Competition
- Applications: ~ 5,000 per year
 - Acceptance Rate: ~ 40%
 - Acc. Rate for invited talks: ~ 10%

DAAD Funding for Doctoral Students

Travel Grants – Deadlines and Information



Deadlines

- Conferences: 4 months prior to conference start
- Invited talks: 1 month prior to departure

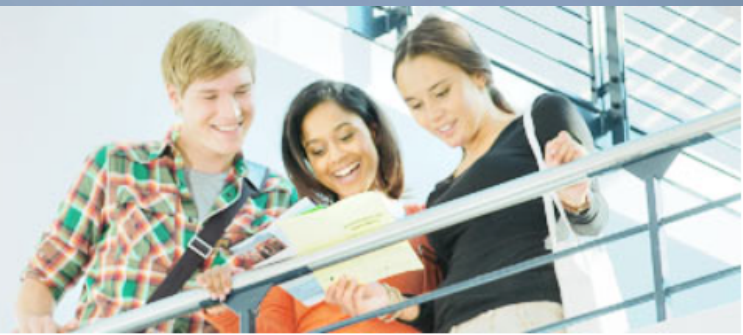
